On the weekend of July 23-24, 2011, **BigDaveSports** hosted the **Midwest Regional Masters Championship** in Southwestern Ohio and Southeastern Indiana. This was a series of three bicycle races bringing in Masters aged riders (30 years or old) from 13 states including California and Florida.

As part of this event, BigDaveSports put together **Bikes 2 Bookbags**, a program to raise money to provide school supplies for under-privileged children. There were three ways money was being raised:

1. For each registered rider, BigDaveSports donated \$1 to the program,
2. Business Sponsors of the event could contribute money to the program, and
3. The riders, themselves could make additional contributions to the program.

The 2011 event, in it's first year, was able to raise **\$398** for Bike 2 Bookbags. This was from 278 registered riders, \$100 in company sponsorships, and \$20 from rider contributions.
